Category	Self-Assessment Questions	Score (1-5)	Notes/Next Steps
Tithing & Giving	Am I consistently tithing and giving offerings? Do I give cheerfully?		
Budgeting	Am I managing a budget and living within my means?		
Debt Management	Am I actively paying down debt and avoiding unnecessary borrowing?		
Savings & Investments	Am I building savings, emergency funds, and future-focus investments?		
Generosity & Impact	Beyond tithe, am I blessing others, sowing into Kingdom work, or supporting community?		
Faith Alignment	Do my financial decisions reflect trust in God's provision and alignment?		
Time & Talents	Am I stewarding my gifts, time, and skills as much as my finances?		

SCORING

1-2 = Needs Growth - Identify immediate changes you can make.

3 = Consistent - You're steady but can strengthen further.

4-5 = Strong Stewardship - You're operating as a faithful steward.
